✂ DT: Cooking- Fruit Kebabs.

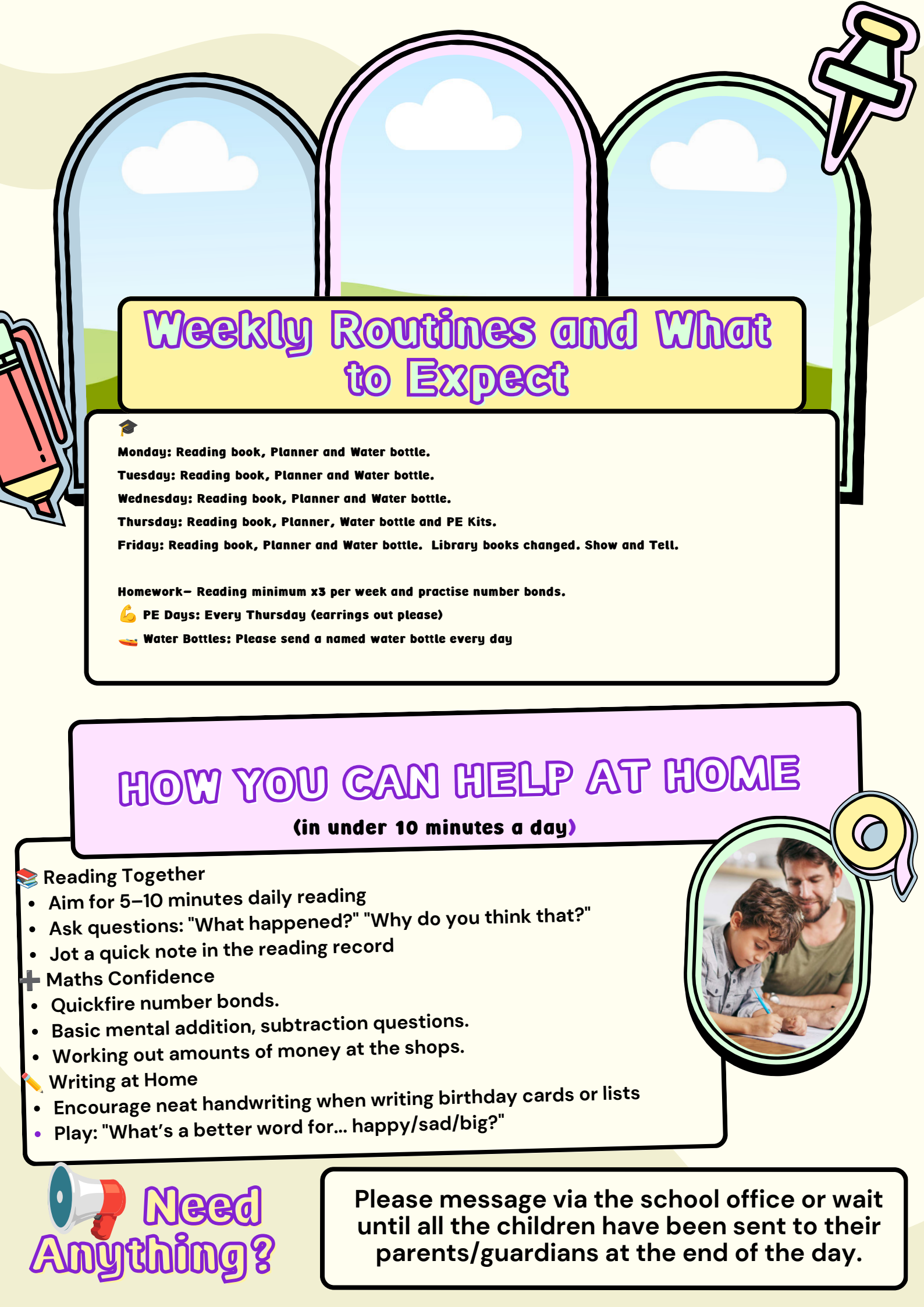
🏛 History: Toys Old and New

Writing at Home

- Encourage neat handwriting when writing birthday cards or lists
- Play: "What's a better word for... happy/sad/big?"
