Each week, children have the opportunity to earn a star by completing their home learning:

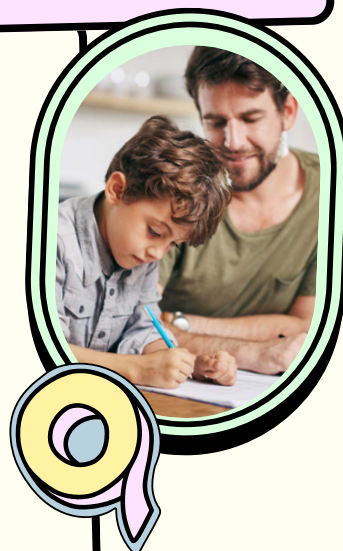
- 📖 reading at least three times
